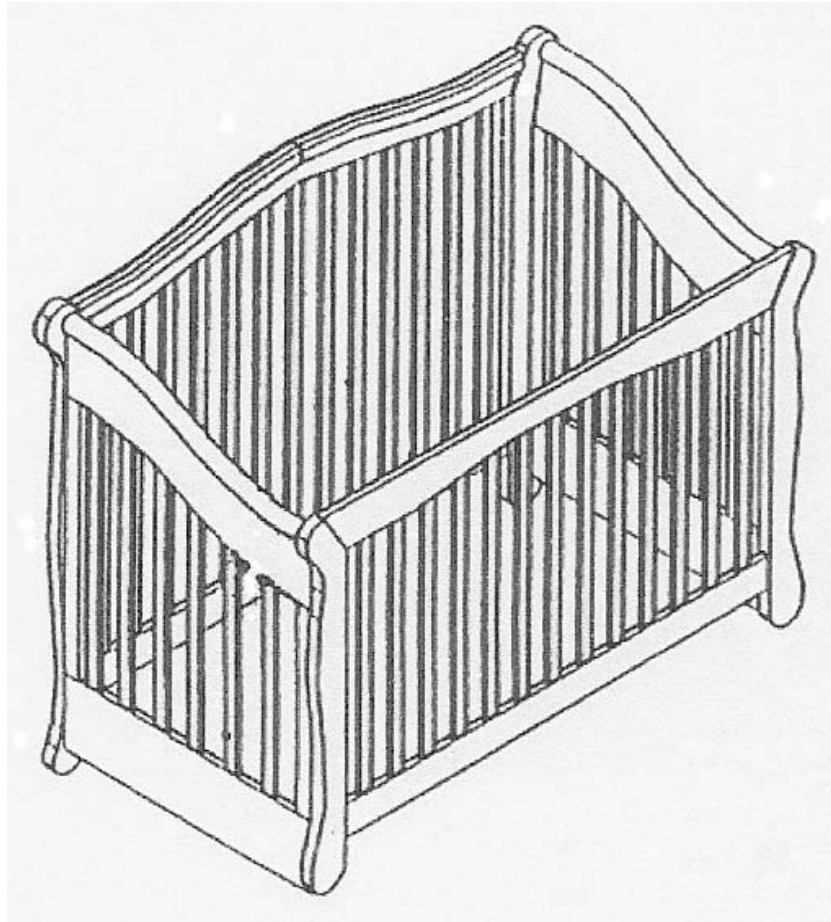

WARNING

- ✦ Do not use this crib if the enclosed or attached instructions cannot be strictly adhered to.
- ✦ Do not use this crib if the child is able to climb out unaided or is taller than 90 cm (35 inches).
- ✦ Do not place cords, straps or similar items that could become wound around the child's neck in or near this crib.
- ✦ Ensure that the sides are properly latched or locked in place when the crib is occupied.
- ✦ The mattress used with this crib should not be more than 15 cm (6 inches) thick and should be of such length and width that gap between the mattress and the sides of the crib is not more than 3 cm (1 1/4 inches) when the mattress is pushed into the corner of the crib.

MISE EN GARDE

- ✦ Ne pas utiliser le lit d'entant à moins d'etre en mesure de respecter rigoureusement le mode d'emploi ci-joint ou apposé sur le produit.
- ✦ Ne pas utiliser le lit d'enfants si l'enfant est capable d'en sortir sans aide ou si l'enfant mesure plus de 90 cm (35 puces).

- ✦ L'épaisseur du matelas utilise dans le lit ne doit pas être supérieure à 15 cm (6 pouces) et sa longueur et sa largeur doivent être telles que l'espace entre le matelas et les cores au lit ne soit pas superieur a 3 cm (1 1/4 pouce) lorsque le matelas est pousse dans un des coins.

AFTER RAISING SIDE, MAKE SURE LATCHES ARE SECURE.
WHEN CHILD IS ABLE TO CLIMB OUT OR REACHES THE HEIGHT OF 35 IN. (90 CM), THE CRIB SHALL NO LONGER BE USED.
DO NOT PLACE CRIB NEAR WINDOW WHERE CORDS FROM BLINDS OR DRAPES MAY STRANGLE A CHILD, IF REFINISHING, USE A NON-TOXIC FINISH SPECIFIED FOR CHILDREN'S PRODUCTS.
DO NOT USE A WATER MATTRESS WITH THIS CRIB.

Thank you for selecting a **MOTHER HUBBARD'S CUPBOARDS** product.

To ensure the best performance from your crib, please read these instructions carefully. If you have any questions or concerns, notify us and we will gladly assist you.

Due to weather patterns and nature, no two trees are alike. One tree can vary in texture, grains and density. This causes the acceptance of stains and sealers to vary. This is the mystery of wood. Knots, blemishes and swirls can appear. These patterns are the elegance and beauty of wood.

Even though we make every effort to bring you the very best style and quality, there will be instances where nature, and not man will decide the look of your furniture.

Carefully remove and lay out all parts. Familiarize yourself with all diagrams. Parts enclosed in hardware bag should correspond with the parts list. Be sure all parts are included, and quantities are correct. You will need a flat head screwdriver, a pair of pliers, Phillips head screwdriver, Alien key, hammer and a small piece of wood.

CLEANING

Mix a mild dishwasher liquid and water solution, apply to crib surface with a soft cloth lightly dampened in the solution. After cleaning, dry all surfaces thoroughly with a soft dry cloth. No abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, steel wool or coarse rags should be used to clean this furniture.

WARNING

Your child's safety is important, please read the safety warning

- Parents should ensure a safe environment for the child by regularly checking that every component is securely in place **BEFORE** placing the child into the crib.
- **NEVER** use plastic shipping bags or other plastic films as mattress covers because they can cause suffocation.
- Infants can suffocate in gaps between crib sides and a mattress that is too small.

WARNING! Infants can suffocate on soft bedding. **Never** add a pillow or comforter.

- **Never** place additional padding under an infant.
- To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants to be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- To help prevent strangulation tighten all fasteners. A child can trap parts of the body or clothing on loose fasteners
- Follow warnings on all products in a crib.

Before each usage or assembly, inspect the crib for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts, or sharp edges. **DO NOT** use the crib if any parts are missing or broken. Contact your dealer or **MOTHER HUBBARD'S CUPBOARDS** for replacement parts and/or instructional literature.

DO NOT substitute parts.

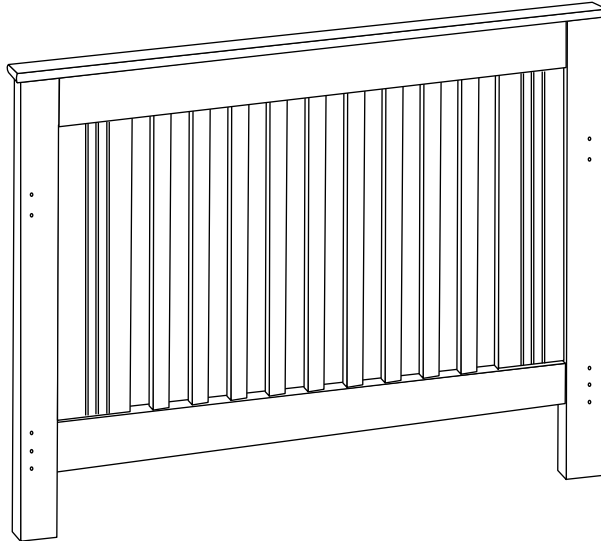
Upon completion of assembly be sure all screws, bolts and fastening devices have been tightened securely. Be sure to do a periodic check to ensure this.

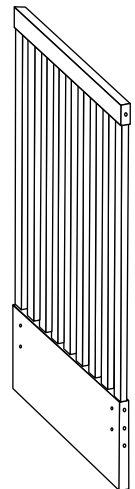

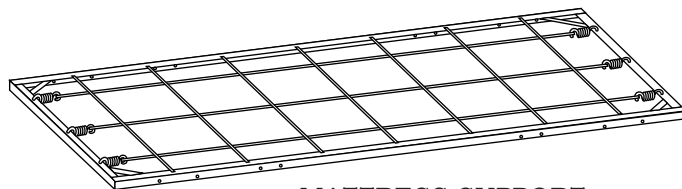
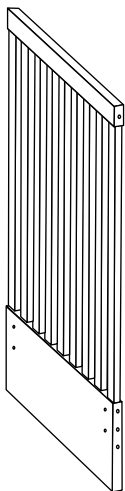
BACK SIDE



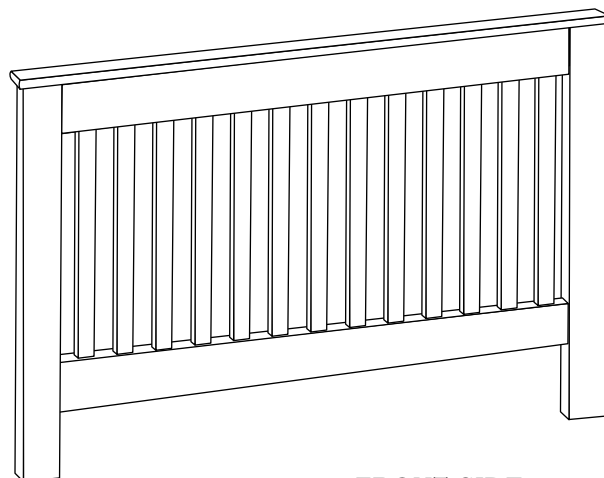
RIGHT SIDE BOARD

MATTRESS SUPPORT



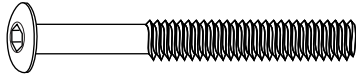
FRONT SIDE

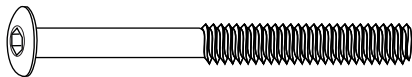

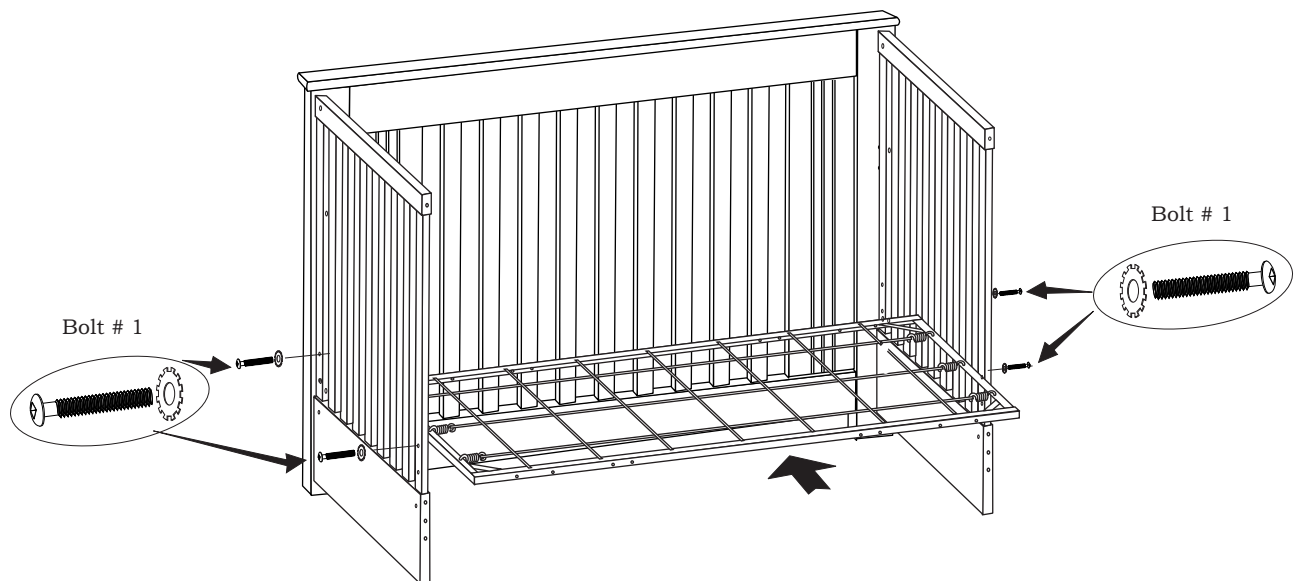
Before each usage or assembly, inspect the crib for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts or sharp edges.

DO NOT use crib if any parts are missing or broken. Contact your dealer, or Mother Hubbard's Cupboards furniture.

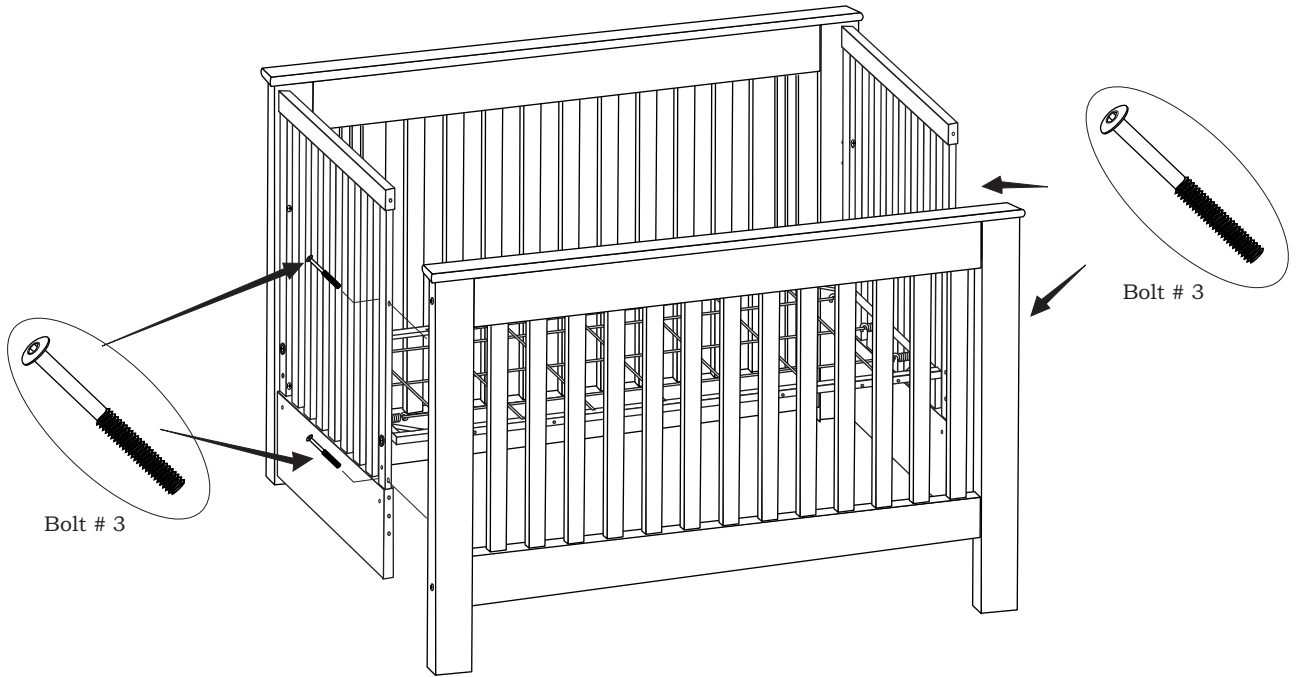
STEP 1 First align the hole on the top of the Side panel with the hole in on the top of the Back panel. Using Bolt #2 attach the Side panels to the Back Side. Then, using Bolt #3 complete the assembly (as shown). Use the same technic for the other Side panel.



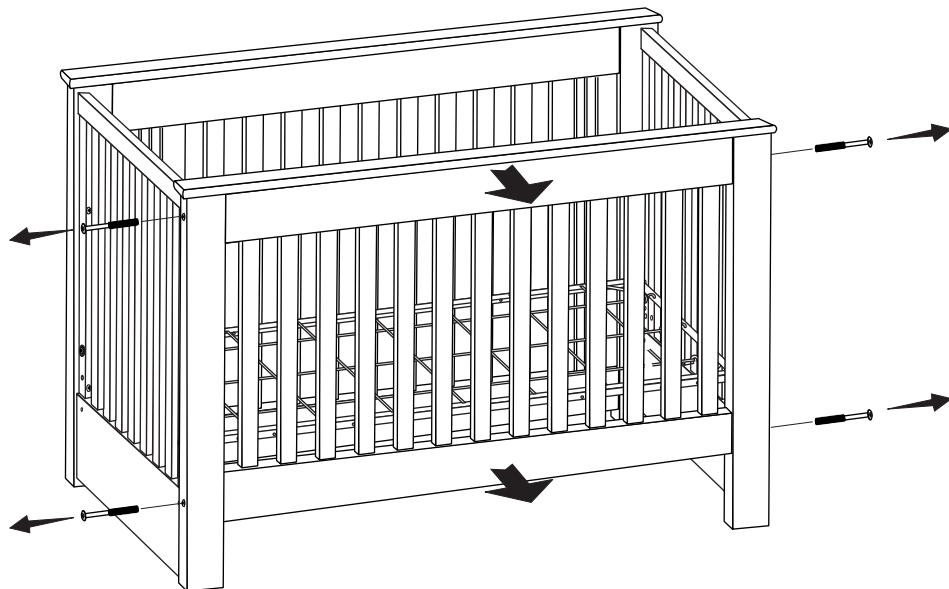
STEP 2 Attach the Mattress Support to it's designated holes on the Side Panels. Choose the desired height. Insert Bolt #1 through the Locking Washer and then into the hole on the Side Panel. Match it to the threaded holes on the Mattress Support's frame. Use the provided Allen key and **FULLY TIGHTEN**



STEP 3 To attach the Front Side to the Side panels, first insert the remaining four Bolts #3 into the holes on the front railing of the Side panels (Left and Right). Align the receiving hole of the Front Side with the Bolts from the Side Panels and tighten the Bolts using the provided Allen key. Revisit and carefully tighten all bolts.



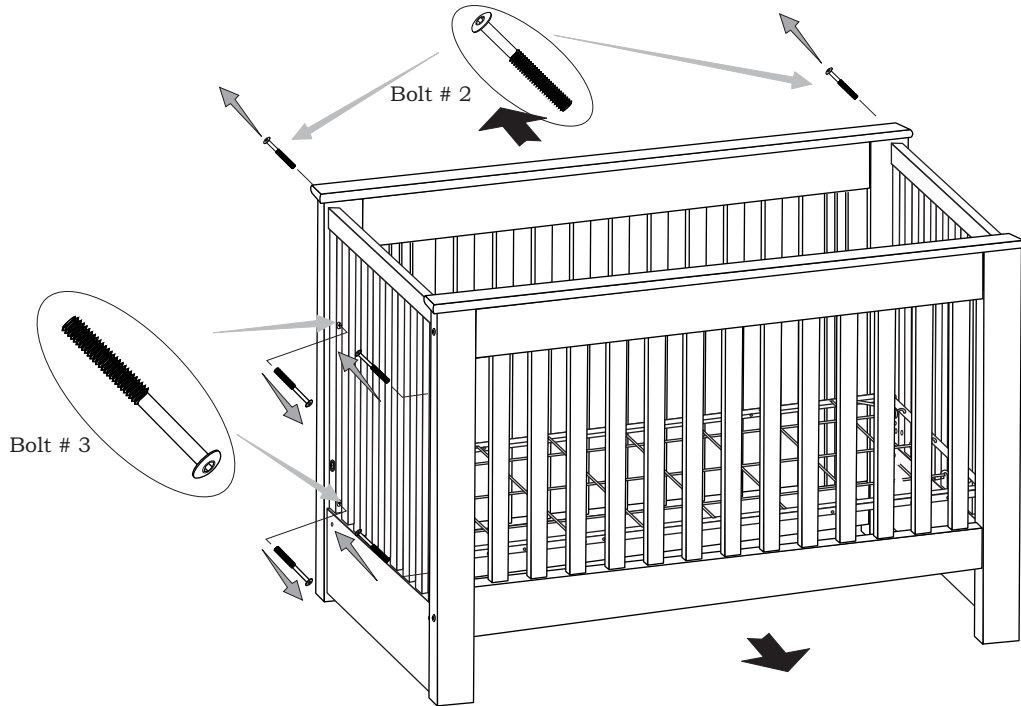
Option 1 If the removal of the front railing is desired, using the Allen key, withdraw the Bolts from the side of the legs of the Front Side as shown. Then remove the front railing subassembly.



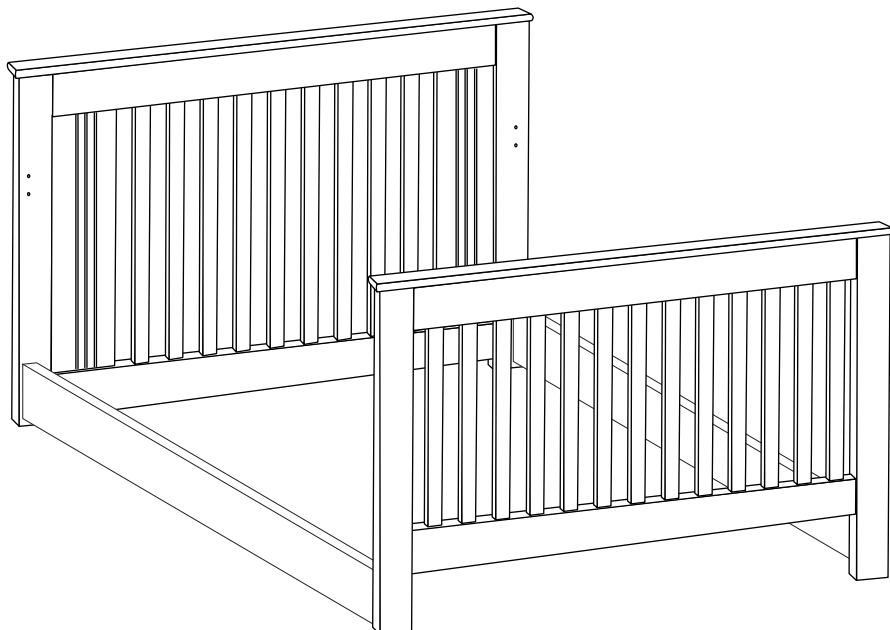
Option 2 Using it as a Full Bed (Full bed kit sold separately)

Withdraw the Bolts#2 and Bolts#3 from the Side panels (Left and Right). From the front as well as from the back. This will free the Front Side and the Back Side.

Install the full bed Kit using the hardware that comes with it, to obtain the frame shown on the lower illustration.

WARNING**FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE WARNINGS AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always ensure a safe environment for the child. Check that every component is properly secured and in place, before placing the child in the crib.
- The crib has an adjustable spring, which serves as a mattress support. For the convenience of the mother when the baby is very small, the spring may be used in the highest position.
- After raising side, make sure latches are secure!
- **IMPORTANT** - With the spring and mattress in their highest position and the mobile frame in the lowered position, be absolutely sure the top of the drop-side is at least 3 inches (7.6 cm) higher than the top surface of mattress. If it is not, lower the spring and mattress to the next highest position and check again.
- When your child is beginning to push up on its hands and knees or is 5 month of age, whichever occurs first, remove all toys which are strung across crib area. These toys cause STRANGULATION!
- When your child is able to pull into a standing position, set the mattress to it's lowest position and remove bumper pads, larger toys and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing our.
- When the child is able to climb out, or reaches the height of 35 inches (90centimeters), the crib should no longer be used. The child should then be placed in a youth or regular bed.
- Strings can cause strangulation! DO NOT place items with a string around the child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. DO NOT suspend strings over crib or attach strings to toys.
- Any mattress used in the crib must be at least 27 1/4 inches (69 centimeters), by 51 5/8 inches (131 centimeters) with a thickness not exceeding 6 inches (15 centimeters). The dimensions of mattress shall be taken from seam to seam or edge to edge where appropriate.
- Never use plastic shipping bags or plastic film as mattress, covers because they can cause suffocation.
- **DO NOT** place crib near window where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
- **DO NOT** place the child in crib with drop-side down. Be sure mobile frame is raised and in locked position whenever the child is in the crib.
- **DO NOT** use a water mattress with this crib.
- Contact Mother Hubbard's Cupboards for replacement parts and instructional literature if Needed.
- When disassembling this crib, **DO NOT** remove any item attached with wood screws.
- If refinishing, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.
- Use a vaporizer near furniture will cause the wood to swell and finish to peel.
